Dear Parishioners,

Our parish mission will be starting on Saturday the 6th of June and continue on through Wednesday June 10th. Deacon Califano will preach all of the Masses for the weekend of the 6th and 7th. For Monday through Wednesday the schedule will be as follows: Deacon Califano will preach the 9am Mass and they give a talk after Mass. At 7pm the blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the Church and Deacon Califano will give a talk. The following is a little bio of Deacon Califano and the focus of each mission day.

Deacon Joseph J. Califano, PhD

Deacon Califano is an internationally recognized scholar in the areas of contemporary moral problems with particular emphasis on moral issues related to medicine, applied sciences, Social Justice and the family. He has publications in Asia, Europe, Canada, USA, and Latin America He has also publications on life issues and marriage in the encyclopedia of the Vatican and the New Catholic encyclopedia. He has given numerous presentations at many national and international conferences. Deacon Califano has taught courses on each of the four Gospels, as to what it means to live each gospel. He and his wife were leaders in a pre-Cana program for 17 years.

As a professor of philosophy for 48 years, he also taught undergraduate and graduate course in ethics, the philosophy of history, the history of philosophy, The nature of historical reasoning and Modernization and human values. He also taught courses in the philosophy of the human person, metaphysics and the problem of God in our contemporary world. Deacon Califano is member of the third order of Saint Dominic and as a deacon he has advised couples in crisis.

The Theme of this Mission or retreat is:

Why is it essential to having a genuinely and fulfilling married life that one have a sacramental marriage, bringing into existence the Family as a Domestic Church.

Part one: the false categories at root of a distortion of the nature of marriage.

Part two: a proper and true understanding of the kinds of love at the foundation of a successful fulfilling marriage.
