Our parish has run out of Chapel keys. If you are in possession of one and not able to visit our Chapel, please return it to the parish office.



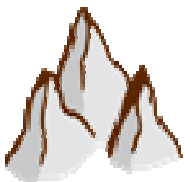
Have you lost an item? Next weekend we will put out a table with items found in the Church and Chapel.
