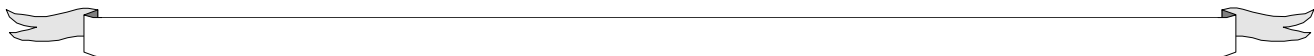

Reconciliation Monday will be on March 26th from 3pm until 9pm. You can go to any Church in the Archdiocese of NY to have your confession heard.

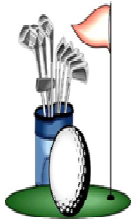


We will be decorating the Church for Easter on Saturday, March 31st at 11:30am. Many hands make light work.
